April 26, 2016 **Circuit/Weights/Locker Rooms** User Group Meeting Minutes

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The Group met to discuss the preliminary User Group drawing. The drawings presented in the meeting are for diagrammatic purposes only, intended to facilitate discussion and visualize spatial adjacencies. The following is a brief summary of topics discussed.

Discussion Topics:

- A. The Group discussed the current locker room usage throughout the Middle School/High School:
 1. Existing Pool Lockers:
 - a. 5th grade- 8th grade PE.
 - b. There can be 200 students at the Pool Locker Rooms at one time for PE.
 - c. Middle School: All Sports.
 - d. High School: Wrestling/Swim Team-Girls/Cross Country.
 - e. Velocity Swim Club-youth swim club.
 - f. Community Swim Use.
 2. Existing High School Gym Locker Rooms:
 - a. 9th Grade Girls PE.
 - b. Gymnastics/Cheerleading.
 - c. Varsity Football, Wrestling.

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- B. Proposed Locker Room Use (after renovations):
 - 1. Ice Arena:
 - a. La Crosse/Hockey/Football (10th -12th grade).
 - b. 38 lockers for each gender optimal.
 - 2. Pool Lockers:
 - a. Community Use.
 - b. Transient lockers for swimming units ideal.
 - c. Will need a family changing room.
 - 3. Exist High School Lockers:
 - a. 7/8th Football, 7/8th PE.
 - b. All 7th/8th grade sports.
 - 4. PE TAC Lockers Upper Level:
 - a. 9th-12th PE.
 - 5. Athletic TAC Lockers Lower Level:
 - a. 9th -12th Athletics (basketball, wrestling, softball, gymnastics, tennis).
 - 6. Community Ed Lockers:
 - a. Some minor renovations are required to finish the space.
 - b. This location could be a potential location for transgender student changing locations.
 - c. An official's space is also required.
 - d. This locker Room is seen as a flex space.
- C. Curriculum: 7-12th grade has swimming units. 5th and 6th graders may still use the pool once the New Intermediate School gets built.
- D. Community Ed to get back to Wold the amount of lockers needed for morning and evening activities.
- E. Athletic Department to get to Wold quantity of students in different sports and a preferred locker size per sport.
- F. Wold to email the PE department head and Athletic Director questions to further quantify locker counts.
- G. Golf clubs will need to be stored in a room somewhere throughout the building.
- H. The Group was in favor of a PE office in both the old High School Gym space and a new PE office in the TAC.
- I. An overall issue building-wide is a lack of storage.
- J. The next User Group will be in approximately two to three weeks.
