

## Questions to Ask a College Admissions Representative

When visiting with a college representative, ask plenty of questions to ensure you choose the college that best matches your needs

### Ask Questions About Academics

What majors or programs do you offer?

What is the average length of your programs?

What percent of your students graduate?

Do you have internship programs?

Will I have an advisor to help me with scheduling and program related questions?

How difficult is it to get the class schedule I need?

Do you offer tutoring services if I need them? If I have an IEP or 504, how will that be transferred?

### Ask Questions about Admissions

When is your enrollment deadline?

What standards do you use for acceptance?

Do I need to take an entrance exam?

### Ask Questions about Financial Aid

What type of financial aid is available to me?

How do I apply?

Do you have a financial aid application deadline?

Are there scholarships available through the college?

What is the total cost of my program including books, fees, and tuition?

### Ask Questions about Student life

What type of housing is available for students?

How many students are enrolled at your college?

What is the average class size?

How big is the largest class?

Do you have student organizations and activities?

Is it required that I live on campus as a freshmen student?

Are classes taught by an instructor or a teacher's assistant?

### Ask Questions About Technology

What type of technology courses are offered at your college?

What equipment and software do you currently use?

Does each student have access to a computer during class time?

Will I have an email account and access to the Internet?

### Ask Questions About Career Services

Do you offer student internships?

Where do I find information regarding recruiters or employers that visit the school?

What type of career placement assistance do you offer?

Will you help me find a part-time job while I attend school?

What is your placement rate?

What types of jobs and salaries are your graduates getting?
