Discussion Topics:

A. High School Special Education Suite:

- 1. EBD Classroom:
 - a. Space for 25 users.
 - b. Furniture-based storage rather than casework.
 - c. Student desks are preferred to tables.
 - d. Quiet Room:
 - 1) No pads required.
 - 2) Carpet.
 - 3) Light switch outside of room.
 - 4) Non-locking door with small amount of glass.
 - 5) No electrical outlets.
 - e. Testing Room:
 - 1) Adjacent to Quiet Room.
 - 2) Needs electrical outlets.
 - 3) Borrowed light for supervision.



- 2. The Special Education Resource room will be used instead as a Project-Based Learning room with space for larger projects:
 - a. There should be (10) half-sized stacked lockers for use by paras in this area. Padlocks will be used with these lockers.
- LD Classroom needs:
 - a. Teaching wall with 16'-0" markerboard and adjacent connections for projector and smartboard.
 - b. (2) Smaller markerboards.

B. DCD:

- 1. The location of the DCD suite in building has been swapped with FACS since the last iteration.
- 2. The existing Apartment Room will be unchanged.
- 3. DCD Classrooms:
 - a. (8) Student lockers for each classroom with hooks, one shelf and no locks.
 - b. Open equipment staging area.
 - c. It would be ideal if the suite had 3'-4" wide doors to allow larger equipment.
 - d. Markerboard with Smartboard and projector connections.
 - e. Upper and lower casework with handicap accessible counter.
 - f. Tall storage casework.
- 4. Quiet Room needs:
 - a. Padding up to 6'-0" on all walls.
 - b. Non-locking door with small amount of glass only.
 - c. Light switch outside of room.
 - d. Central location to allow access for more severe students.
 - e. No power outlets.
- 5. Toilet room:
 - a. Sized for (2) adults and equipment.
 - b. Should have space and power for wheelchair lift.
 - c. Power required for changing table.
- 6. DCD Flex Room needs:
 - a. Used for prep by (12) Paras.
 - b. (12) 12"x12" lockers.
 - c. Large work table.
 - d. Tackboard.
 - e. Power.
 - f. No glass.
 - g. Existing bookshelves from the entry area could be located in this space.
 - h. Uppers and lowers.
 - i. Sink.
- 7. Nurse Area:
 - a. The Nurse does not require a separate enclosed space. Meals will be served in the existing apartment area and tube feedings can take place in the classrooms.
 - b. The nurse can use the sink and counter space in the classrooms.
- C. Middle School Special Education Suite:
 - 1. A second quiet room for the Middle School suite should be included in the DCD room. This room should mirror the features of the High School Quiet Room.

- 2. The LD classrooms should have the same markerboard and technology connections as the High School LD rooms. Wold will verify existing conditions.
- D. The Special Education Resource room (existing) requires (10) half-height double stacked lockers for use by paras. These lockers will be used with padlocks.
- E. The District is pursuing construction of a single stall toilet room with powered changing table and space for lifting equipment near the HS Special Education Suite before construction on this project begins.
- F. There should be a third gender neutral toilet room with powered changing table and space for lifting equipment to the south of the Black Box Theater.
- G. The next User group will occur in approximately one to two weeks.
