## **Preparing for MCA Tests**

We are heading into the last trimester of the 2016-2017 school year. Things are literally heating up! As we head into spring, please keep April's MCA testing in mind. The DMS testing schedule is posted on the middle school website, but the following is a summary of upcoming testing dates. MCA Reading tests will be administered April 3-7, beginning with 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders on Monday and Tuesday and ending with 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders on Wednesday and Thursday. MCA Science tests will begin with 8<sup>th</sup> graders testing on April 10-11, and 5th graders testing on April 12-13. MCA Math tests will be administered April 17-21, beginning with 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders on Monday and Tuesday and ending with 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders on Wednesday and Thursday. Please encourage your child to get plenty of rest, nutritious breakfasts and a balance of leisure/study time as we head into a busy spring schedule of testing.

In addition to testing, the spring is filled with band/choir concerts, extra-curricular activities, Tiger Pride celebrations, the Long Lake Conservation 5<sup>th</sup> grade trip and much more. Please make a concerted effort to plan any family vacations, student appointments and other absences to outside the school day, especially on testing days if at all possible. Regular attendance is crucial as we prepare students for a strong finish academically, socially, physically and emotionally.

We did it! Delano Middle School's goal of \$8,000 was surpassed by \$291.63! This is the highest dollar amount DMS has ever raised in an effort to support the fight against blood cancers. The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) is the world's largest voluntary health agency dedicated to blood cancer. The LLS mission is to cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and myeloma and improve the quality of life of patients and their families. LLS

funds lifesaving blood cancer research around the world while providing free information and support services. In 2016, 3.1 million dollars went to support blood cancer research in Minnesota alone. Over the years, Delano Middle School has raised \$91,594.11 for Pennies for Patients. This equates to 183 families receiving travel expenses of

\$500 each.

Congratulations to Mr. Schramel's class and Mrs. Olson's class for achieving the highest classroom totals. These classrooms will be rewarded with a Domino's Pizza Party.

We want to thank our students, parents, staff and community members for their generous donations towards this important cause. Without your time and contributions, this would not have been possible!




## Winter Activity Day Fun!
