



## **FACILITIES COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP**

**Objective:** To develop a Community Planning Group process to study data, review facilities, and discuss criteria, goals, and options to arrive at a consensus for addressing facility needs.

**Membership:** Membership was developed through an open call for applicants and recruitment in August and September. Applicants were reviewed by district administration to ensure broad community representation. The goal is for the Committee to represent educators, community members, parents, property owners and other interested stakeholders in Delano Schools.

**Responsibilities:** Members will be required to attend all of the Committee meetings to gain a firsthand knowledge of the District facilities through review of data and information, tours, and engaged discussion. They will develop criteria identifying the issues to be resolved in the buildings, prioritize needs, and consider Options that address these issues. Through consensus based discussion and agreement the Committee will determine the best short term (2-5 year) and long term (5-10 year) recommendation for addressing these needs through implementation.

*It should be noted that it is the Committee's responsibility to make a recommendation to the School Board on facilities. Once this recommendation is made, it is the Board's responsibility to consider the recommendation and determine the best course of action for implementation.*

**Meeting Norms:**

- Respect schedules and attendance
- Communicate openly and honestly
- Reveal your interests & work toward common good
- Decisions and discussion should be shared publicly as a group
- There are no pre-conceptions for solutions
- Consensus means a willingness to move forward – not a unanimous or majority vote
